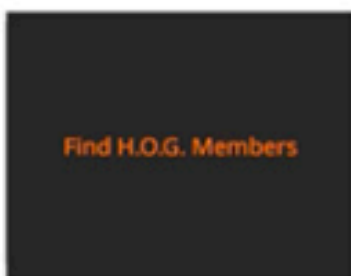

Find the Latest Chapter Forms

The Chapter Membership Enrollment Form and Release, aka “waiver,” protects officers and chapters from liability in the case of an accident that occurs during a chapter event. This form has been recently updated and may now be signed by chapter members upon renewing or enrolling in chapter membership for 2025 and remains in effect for the entire year.

The resource page is a repository of important documents and useful tools to help you manage chapter operations, including the Chapter Charter, Chapter Handbook, event insurance forms and incident reports. Bookmark it and refer to it whenever you need to download one of these forms to ensure you have the most up to date version.

RIDE 365

Get Mileage Readings Completed Before 12/31

Members in warm parts of the country still have a few weeks of riding left to rack up miles in the 2024 Ride 365 Annual and Chapter mileage challenges. But even if your members have put their bikes away for the season, it's not too late to have odometer readings taken for this year's challenges. Chapter holiday parties and other gatherings between now the end of year are great opportunities to invite members to visit your dealership to have those readings completed before the December 31 deadline. Don't let your members take a zero this year!

Use the Member Report function in the Manage My Chapter tool to track participation. This report shows which members have entered the challenge and their mileage totals. A member with a number greater than zero in the annual mileage field has received at least two odometer readings in the current calendar year. A zero means only one reading has been taken. A dash (-) indicates no readings have been taken and the member is not entered in the current Annual Mileage Challenge.

Here's another tip: Ask your members to confirm that they have selected your chapter as their designated chapter in their membership profile on members.hog.com. If they have not designated a chapter, their mileage may not properly roll up into your chapter's overall total for the Chapter Mileage Challenge.

CHAPTER TIP

Submitting Photos for Ride 365 Challenges

Participating in H.O.G. Ride 365 Challenges like the Dealership Check-in Challenge, 10 for '24, and 50 Rides, One Nation is simple, but members often misunderstand how to submit the required photographs to receive credit for their accomplishments. Photo submissions for these riding challenges must be uploaded to the member's profile at members.hog.com , not through the H-D App. Similarly, official mileage readings must be recorded at an authorized Harley-Davidson dealer to enter the Ride 365 Mileage Challenges. Miles accumulated during online riding challenges are not automatically applied to a member's Annual or Lifetime Mileage totals.
