## Before You Register

- Meet with your H.O.G. Manager and fellow officers to agree upon and select your chapter's ROC attendees
- Identify which session you would like to attend
  - Space at each session is limited. You may need to pick an alternate session if your first choice is full.
  - Register as early as possible to reserve your spot.
  - A current officer must register on behalf of any new or potential officer attendees
- Each chapter can send up to six (6) chapter officers. They can be a combination of Primary Officers, Discretionary Officers, or potential future officers. Non-officer guests should not attend ROC training sessions.
- H.O.G. Managers, Dealer Principals and other engaged dealer staff are encouraged to attend as well and are not included in six-participant limit

- Registration closes two weeks prior to each session. However, individual sessions may close sooner if all spaces are filled.
