View Annual & Lifetime Mileage in the H-D App

Thanks to new enhancements to the H-D App, H.O.G. members can now view their mileage achievements easily from a phone or mobile device. Connecting a membership profile to the app allows riders to see how many miles they have accumulated H.O.G.'s Ride 365 Annual and Lifetime challenges and how close they are to their next reward milestone. Riders can also use the H-D App to build and track rides, find nearby events, join riding challenges and connect with fellow riders online.

To enter the Ride 365 and Let's Ride Challenge challenges, riders must continue having odometer readings taken at a Harley-Davidson dealership (see below for more details). Miles recorded with the H-D App will not be automatically enrolled into challenges.



The 2025 Let's Ride Challenge™ Ride for Heroes, which celebrates our riding community while honoring our nation's Military, Veterans and First Responders, is halfway to its 50-million-mile goal. Riders across the country are logging miles, earning rewards, and climbing the leaderboard, all while supporting a \$1 million donation to charities serving those who protect us here at home. Open to all Harley-Davidson riders, the challenge runs through October 31, 2025, and offers collectible rewards at various milestone check-ins. The challenge culminates with five riders winning new 2025 Harley-Davidson motorcycles.

To enter your miles, which also enrolls H.O.G. members in the Ride 365 mileage program, stop at a Harley-Davidson[®] dealership to get an odometer reading. The process is simple:

- · Scan the in-store QR code
- · Enter your member number, VIN and odometer mileage
- Get validated by a dealership employee by scanning the QR code they provide.
- Use this process to enter the challenge even if you have already entered the 2025 H.O.G. Ride 365 challenge. Once you've registered, miles recorded as part of the Let's Ride Challenge[™] will start counting toward your H.O.G. Ride 365 balance.

Photo Submissions for H.O.G. Challenges
